
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

[Facing East, the one who prays recollects his thoughts, and makes the sign of the Cross, as the leader says:]

† In the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, one true God forever and ever. Amen. Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty. Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest!

Blessed is He who has come and is to come in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest!

Holy are you, the Mighty.
Holy are you, the Immortal.
Who were crucified for us †, have mercy on us.

[This is said three times- each time the worshipper prostrates or bows his head and makes the sign of the Cross.]

Have mercy upon us, O Lord. Have pity and mercy upon us, O Lord. Receive our services and prayers and have mercy upon us, O Lord.

Glory to you, O God. Glory to you, O Creator. Glory to you, O Christ the King, who have compassion on your sinful servants. Barekmor.

Hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven. O Lord, by the prayers of your Holy Apostles, may we triumph over this world and its fleeting desires and, like them, may we instead desire the everlasting joy of eternal life in the world to come and be made worthy an inheritance with them in Heaven. May your grace help us not to fear those who kill the body but not the soul, but rather to fear you who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna. May your grace strengthen us to purify and sanctify our souls through asceticism and to live in a Christian manner.

O Lord, accept our fast and prayers as once you received the body and soul of your Mother in Heaven at the time of her death, accompanied by the angels, prophets, apostles, martyrs, ancient patriarchs, and all the holy ones. May the evil one and his powers, who unceasingly attempt to separate us from you, run away in shame.

• Lord, with enlightened fasting and purity of body and soul, make us worthy to celebrate the feast of your Mother's death and assumption into heaven at the end of this fast.

If, in your mercy to-ward us, you sent your Only-begotten Son to become incarnate, there is nothing that can obstruct your great mercy from removing the imperfections of our service and from forgiving our sins.

Before your great mercy, our sins are like a small stain in a large ocean. Having received your mercy and the forgiveness of sins, make us worthy, O God, to praise and glorify you with the angels on the Feast of our Savior's Birth and to witness the Miracle with the shepherds; grant, O Lord, that having recognized your love for us, and with pure hearts, we praise and glorify you, and your Only-begotten Son, and your Holy Spirit, now and always and forever. Amen.

Morning Prayer

• God, we take refuge in prayer and fasting to drive out our adversary, Satan, since, as your Only-begotten Son taught us, the evil one is defeated and driven out only through fasting and prayer. May this fast be for us, succor and stronghold.

Though your Only-begotten Son freed us from servitude to Satan, we are again brought under his rule through our wicked deeds. Through fasting and prayer, make us worthy to wholeheartedly delight in the great Feast of our freedom from this captivity.
